Home-Delivered Meals

- Our largest program, Home-Delivered Meals, served 336,451 meals to 2,068 seniors!
- Volunteer and staff drivers deliver a meal, a friendly smile, and social connection.
- Caseworkers make home visits and telephone assessments to focus on providing more resources.
- Caseworkers provide supportive community resources as Cal Fresh, Senior Connection, Rebuilding Together, transportation, food banks, and other nutritional programs.


- Through generous community donations we provided more than 1,700 gifts to our participants during the winter holidays.
